Dear President,

It is with great pleasure that I inform you about the main decisions and topics discussed during the meeting of the Executive Committee of ASCAME on 17th November 2021 held at Casa Llotja de Mar and online:

- ASCAME REACTIVATES ARBITRATION AND MEDIATION CENTRE PROJECT

Few years ago, ASCAME approved the creation of an Arbitration and Mediation Centre based in Barcelona with an antenna in Beirut to bring this commercial culture to all companies in the region. The circumstances and events in the region in the last 10 years have forced us to be more prudent. Today we will have to take risks and not wait any longer to create this important instrument to facilitate trade and investment not only at the regional level but also between the Mediterranean and the rest of the world. For this reason, the Barcelona Chamber of Commerce will disposition of ASCAME its historical reference centre for arbitration and mediation the consulate of the sea to accelerate this important project. It also proposes that one of the great experts in this matter and current head of the Consul of the Sea Mr Jordi Domingo coordinates an ASCAME working committee constituted by experts from various centres in the region belonging to the ASCAME network of Chambers, for its implementation.

- THE 40TH ANNIVERSARY ASCAME AND 100 ANNIVERSARY OF THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE OF ALEXANDRIA WILL INCLUDE TWO LARGE FORUMS, A GALA DINNER, AND A SERIES OF BUSINESS AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES IN ALEXANDRIA

The initial proposal is to organize two events, one for the digitalization of the Chambers and the other on climate change and the role of the private sector, since Egypt will host COP27 in 2022. It will combine the 40th anniversary of ASCAME with the commitment to digitization and the revolution of Mediterranean Chambers Chamber 4.0. ASCAME will approve a declaration of 27 initiatives on behalf of the private sector from the three continents to present at the COP 27 summit. The event will also include playful and cultural events such as tourist and cultural excursions to the New Egyptian Museum, the Egyptian Pyramids and the lighthouse of Alexandria among others. The event will end with a great dinner with Mediterranean artists and delivery of Mediterranean awards and ASCAME medals.

- FOLLOW UP ON THE 'ASCAME 2018-2022 STRATEGIC PLAN'



The aim of the strategic plan is to reinforce the potential of the Chambers of Commerce as fundamental pieces in the economic scenario of the Mediterranean region and ensure that the efforts at the local level have a regional and international impact and recognition.

The main aim is to recover various projects approved by ASCAME in recent years, as the situation in the region has not allowed us to develop such as calling on the Mediterranean private sector to actively engage towards SDGs 2030, unifying the promotion and finance of the Mediterranean SMEs, consolidating Social Corporate Responsibility in the region, the Mediterranean Mediation and Arbitration Centre. In addition, supporting the integrated transport and multimodal network in the Mediterranean, promoting the Mediterranean Tourism Council, reinforcing the Mediterranean Brand, among others.

- MEDAWEEK 2021, A GREAT SUCCESS FOR ASCAME TO PROMOTE THE MEDITERRANEAN ECONOMY AND REGIONAL INTEGRATION
